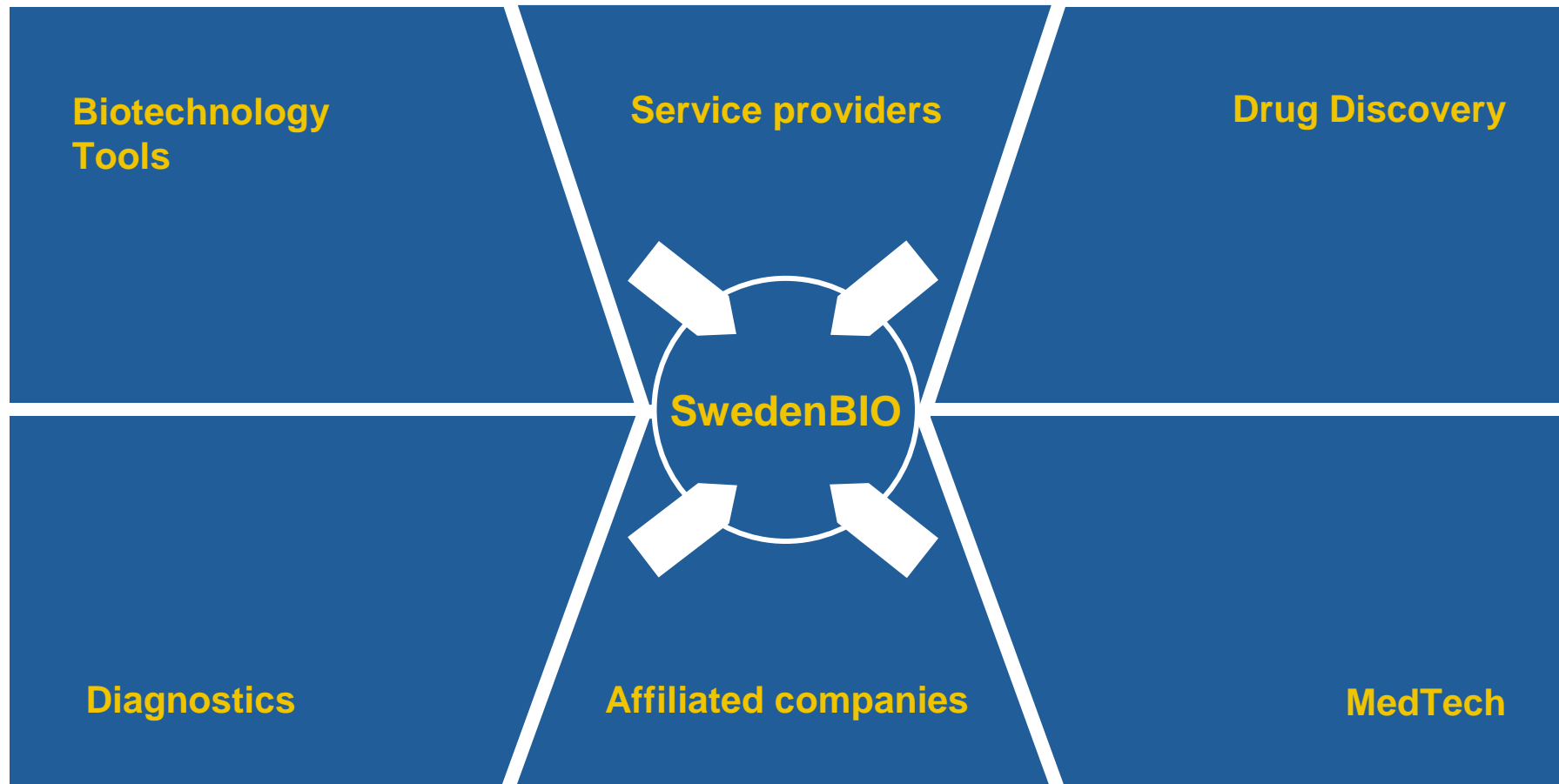

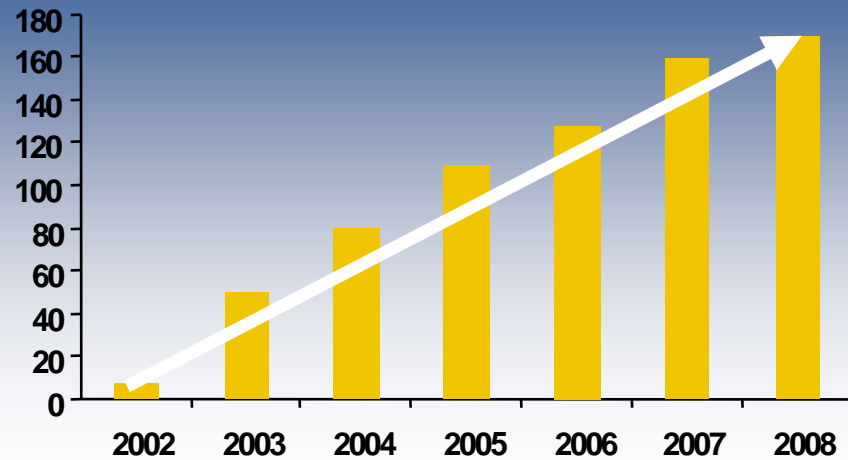

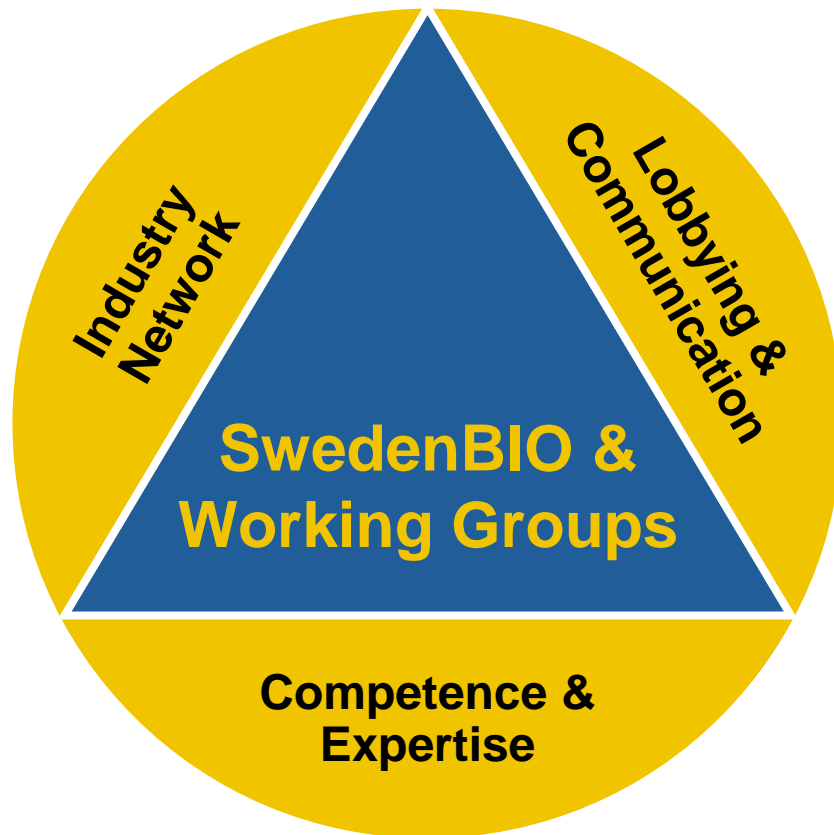

Member Growth



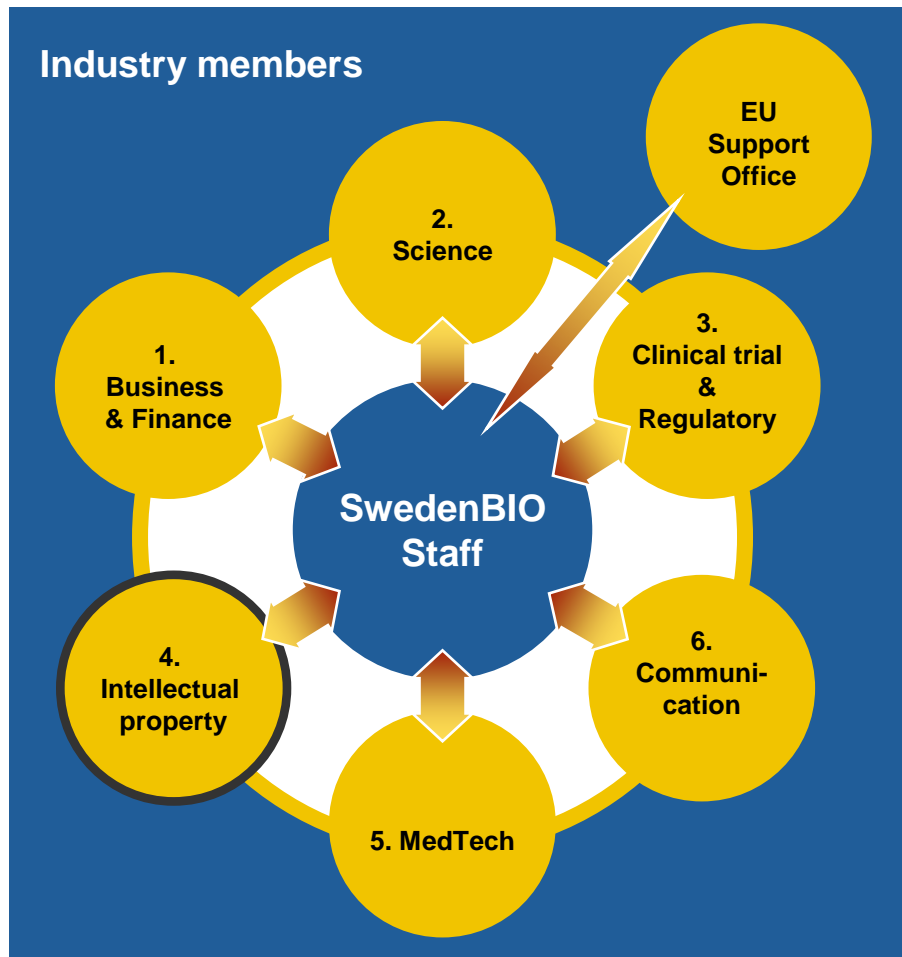
